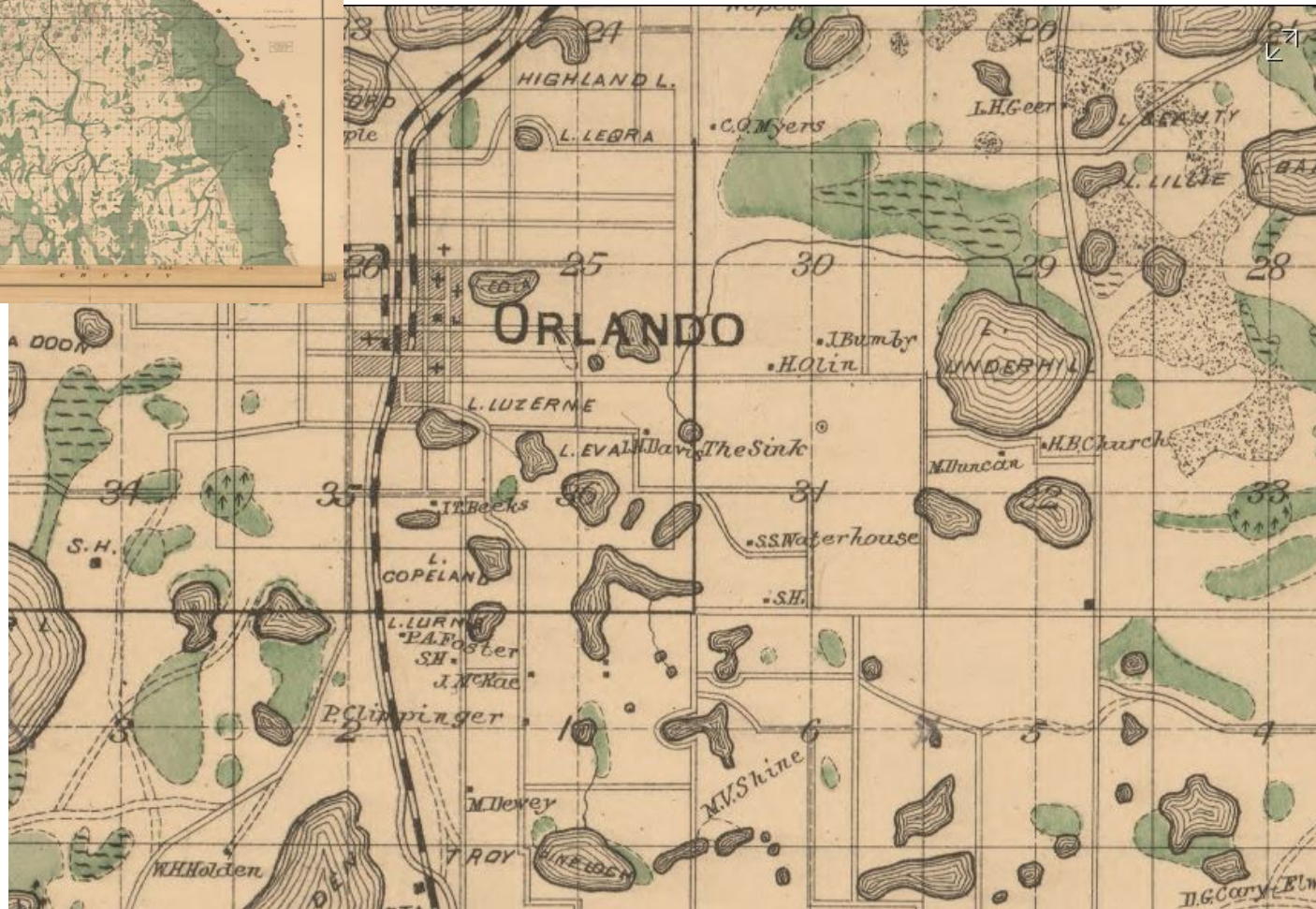
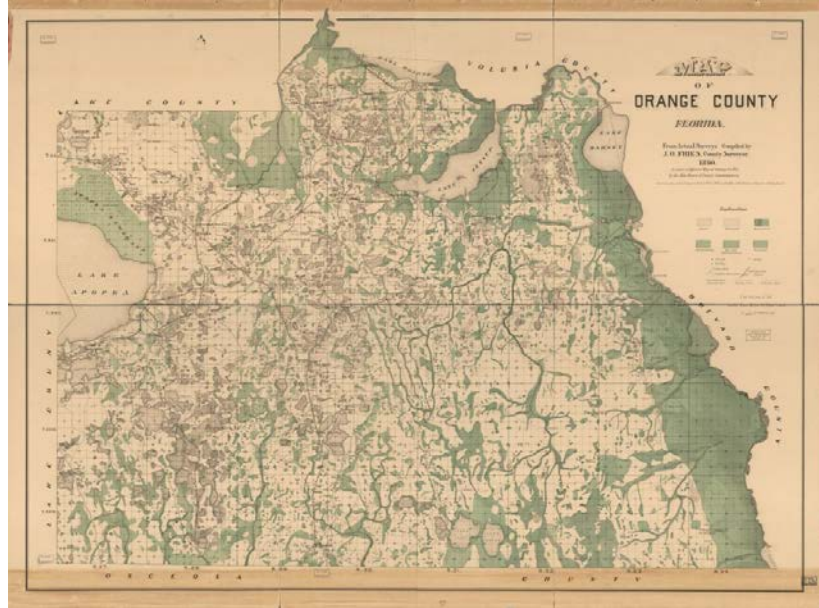

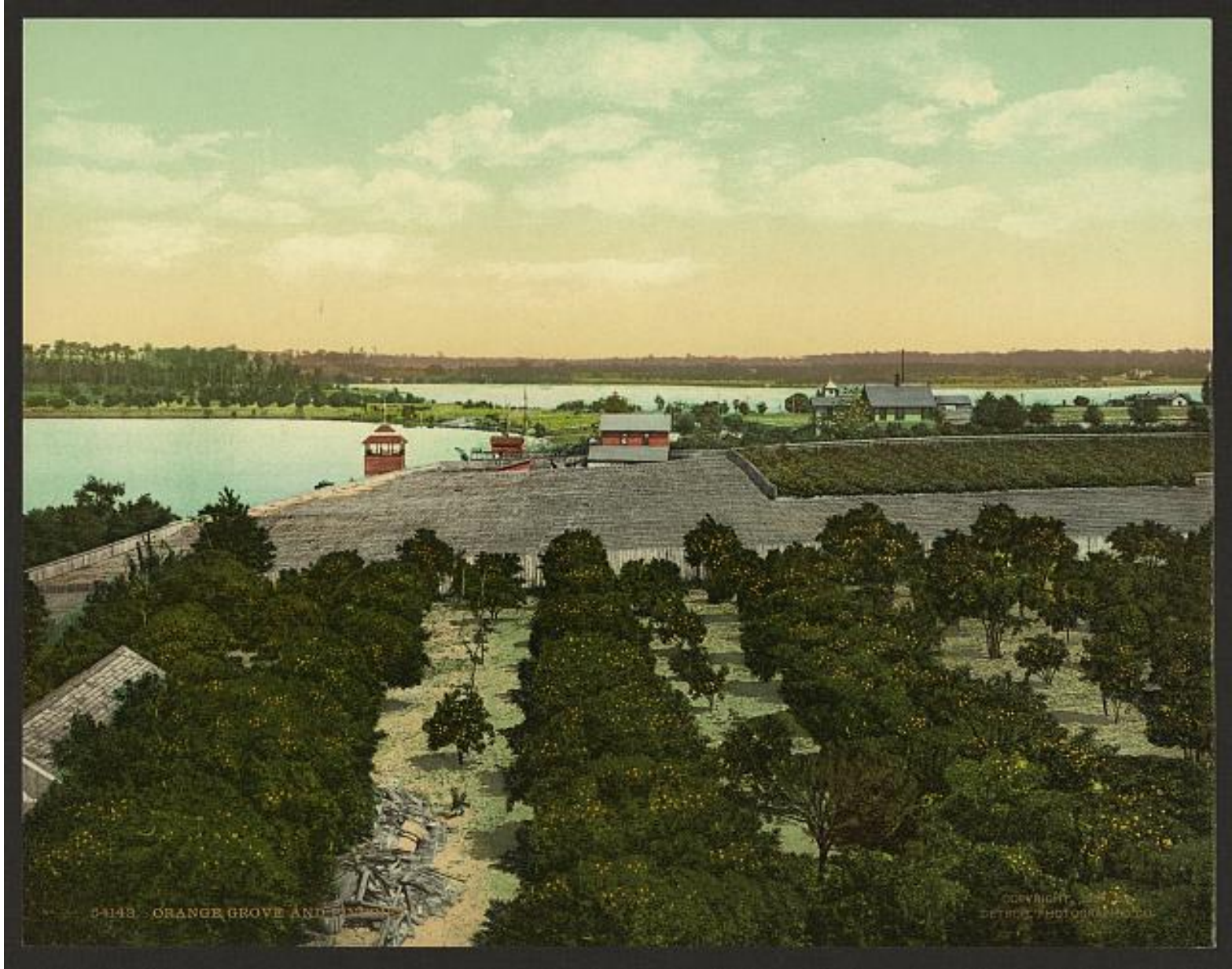


L'Isle, Guillaume De. *Carta geografica della Florida nell' America settentrionale*. [Venezia, 1750] Map. G&M Division.

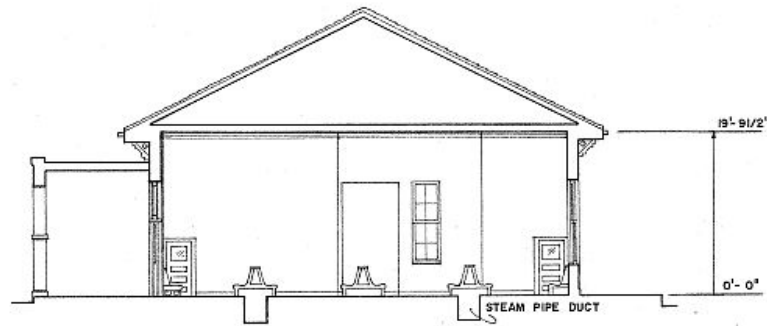




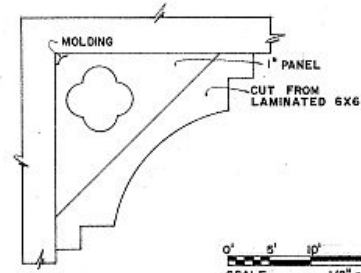
SECTION A

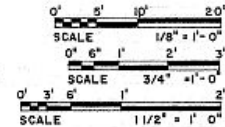
SETTEE SECTION

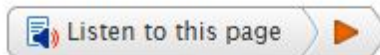
