Why Al-powered storage is coming

- 80% of the world's Internet traffic is video. Up from just
 65% 2 years ago.
- Object storage was invented just 20 years ago to handle unstructured data.
- Today, 90% of all stored data is <u>unstructured data!</u>
- Structured data is easily searchable. <u>Unstructured data is</u> not.



Why Al-powered storage is coming

- Imagine the New York Public Library with no card catalog.
- Over 54 million books, maps, documents, recordings.





Most data is in the dark



Unstructured

80% of the world's growing amount of data is unstructured.

Manual

Unstructured data is difficult to search so it goes unused.

Inaccessible

Organizations hope Al and ML will identify and tag key data to make it more accessible.



What's the point of migrating to the cloud if you still can't find anything?



Storage isn't the problem. Search is the problem.



Existing Al-based solutions for Media





Setting up and managing AI platforms takes time and requires too many resources.



Complex

Lots of toolkits, few turnkey solution making integration with applications required.

Expensive

AWS Rekognition is \$50/hour plus storage. Costs escalate from API calls, egress, and other hidden fees.

UI CAPABILITIES

- Google-like search by people, keywords, tags, visual text, speech-to-text, logos, etc.
- Train your own model (e.g. Upload faces)
- Create collections and categories
- Find duplicate files
- Match to social trends
- Manage users, roles, and groups





AI Processing Simplified

- AI and Storage integrated in a single, ready-to-use service
- Automatic processing
- Content and metadata always accessible
- Run queries via web UI or export metadata via API (JSON) or export CSV, XML sidecars
